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Course Description

This course aims at fostering an awareness of the multiplicity and complexity of the communicative repertoires in multilingual settings. It also complements the contents of the compulsory subject 'Bilingualism and Multilingualism' offered in the first semester. The course starts with an introduction to common terminology in the field and to the concept of multilingual literacies and its implications. It then proceeds to analyse multilingualism in relation to aspects such as: demography, society and identity, language acquisition, education policies and language use in the workplace.

Methodology

Classes will focus on the readings suggested and different tasks will be proposed in relation to these readings. Group debates will also be promoted.

Assessment

Continuous assessment:

Students will be asked to prepare a presentation in groups (35%) and to hand in a critical review of two articles (55%). Class attendance and participation will also be taken into consideration (10%).

One-off assessment:
A critical review of several articles (100%).
